Description The first semester will be essentially focused on the student's grammar, syntax, conjugation acquisition and the correction of important pronunciation defects, as well as developing oral and written comprehension, and introducing small practical and technical writing exercises.

- introduce yourself in French;
- use sentences of everyday life;
- give your opinion / preferences;
- know words expressing quantity (numbers, more or less ...) space (here, there, in front...) and time (now, after, before...);
- conjugate basic verbs.
