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UNYP Research Vision for 2029

In 2029, the University of New York in Prague (UNYP) has emerged as a respected regional research institution with a well-established research portfolio and an extensive international network of collaborative partners. UNYP has positioned itself as a hub for knowledge exchange and the execution of impactful research projects.

Key highlights of UNYP's research ecosystem in 2029 include:

In its pursuit of achieving distinguished status as a higher education institution, UNYP is steadfastly committed to the advancement of knowledge through cutting-edge research. Our research initiatives are strategically organized into specialized Research Centers, each dedicated to addressing critical issues within priority research areas (see below). This systematic approach ensures that UNYP remains at the forefront of academic and intellectual innovation.

By strategically managing the priority research areas within specialized Research Centers, UNYP ensures that its research endeavors are impactful and aligned with contemporary challenges and

opportunities. Through these systematic efforts, UNYP is poised to contribute significantly to the global academic community and positively influence the world at large.

UNYP academic programs and priority research areas

UNYP's research priorities span a wide array of fields, reflecting the university's commitment to addressing critical issues and advancing knowledge. Here are the research priorities at UNYP, derived from the provided text:

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- **Economics:** Researching topics related to the labor market, the public sector, institutions, and international trade.

- **Sociolinguistics:** Researching topics related to communication and media, propaganda, and political communication, with a focus on globalization, democratization and ethical considerations within the current legal and economic settings.

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- **Political Science:** Investigating voting behavior, party politics, and populism, as well as delving into American and world history, EU history, and the Cold War.
- **African Studies:** Concentrating on international organizations, EU, NATO, and collective security in the African context.

- **Peace Studies:** Exploring peace operations, peacebuilding, conflict analysis, conflict management and transformation, conflict prevention, and the privatization of security.
- **Security Studies:** Investigating (counter)terrorism, (counter)insurgency, hybrid/irregular warfare, modern warfare, environmental security, strategy and defense policy planning and development, international law, international humanitarian law, and human rights.

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- **Child Development:** Understanding the factors that influence child development is crucial for promoting healthy growth and well-being in future generations.
- **Educational Psychology:** Research in this area can improve teaching methods and learning outcomes, which have a profound impact on education systems, student success and holistic well-being as lifelong learners.
- **Social Psychology:** Exploring how individuals interact and are influenced by social factors is fundamental for understanding human behavior, relationships, and societal dynamics.
- **Neuroscience and Mental Health:** Given the increasing importance of mental health, particularly in today's society, research in this area is critical for addressing mental health disorders and improving overall well-being by understanding underlying neural mechanisms as well as behavioral patterns.
- **Personality & Behavior:** Understanding how personality traits influence attitudes and behavior is essential for addressing issues like prejudice and promoting positive social interactions.

Research plan 2024-2029:

CENTER FOR BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC RESEARCH

The Center for Business and Economic Research aims to consolidate and harmonize their research outcomes over the upcoming five years. The research center aims to uphold the overarching school-wide objective to enhance the overall volume of peer-reviewed publications among full-time faculty members (especially among course guarantors). Further, trainings and workshops are planned for faculty members and instructors to increase the total amount of publications and outputs in professional journals and community outlets. Additionally, the research center aims to support external grant applications at international and national funding agencies through regular meetings and support of the research lead, reminding staff of the incentive schemes. Additionally, the research center would like to integrate activities that lead to more interdisciplinary research topics and attract more diversified teams of instructors and faculty staff. The School of Business also aims to incentivize the publication of excellent final projects and theses by the students and foster the communication of the key findings to the

relevant stakeholders. Currently the research center is pursuing new opportunities for collaborative projects (currently in the area of entrepreneurship and digital skills training for people with disabilities)

MEDIA RESEARCH CENTER

The Media Research Center aims to solidify and unify their research output in the next five years, on both quantitative and qualitative levels. On the quantitative side, the research center maintains the general school-wide priority to increase the volume of publications among full time faculty members (also referred to as course guarantors). Further, mentoring is planned for non-full time, industry-based instructors to boost the overall sum, particularly in professional journals. Additionally, the research center aims to significantly increase applications for external grants on both the international and local level. On the qualitative side, the research center would like to attempt to integrate research focuses in order to unify approaches, leading to more elastic themes. Although the research center has from the beginning seen the comprehensive and diverse approaches of its faculty as its strength, due to the small size of the program, and the interest in collaborative projects amongst faculty, a more collective approach is intended to be pursued. The arrival of JUDr. Radka MacGregor Pelikánová, Ph.D., LL.M., MBA has seen this begin to emerge, with projects in developing connecting law and linguistics; disinformation, public relations and corporate social responsibility; cultural values and corporate communications, and more.

CENTER FOR INTERNATIONAL AND EUROPEAN AFFAIRS

The Center for International and European Affairs seeks to further develop its research agenda that focuses on major issues pertaining to global politics. The research activities pursued by core faculty members whose primary institution for conducting research is UNYP should result in publishing in leading disciplinary journals and academic presses, and attendance of prestigious international conferences. Full-time faculty members of the research center aim to apply for Czech funding schemes (such as GACR), relevant foreign grants, enact cooperation with research partners abroad, and become a part of applications by international consortia. Part-time faculty will be involved in these activities to the feasible extent and will participate in School's research activities and events. These activities will be supported by School's Research Lead, Dr. Jakub Zahora. The Research Lead coordinates grant applications among the School's faculty in order to track relevant opportunities and to ensure synergy between individual members' research interests. He further will organize research colloquia which will serve as a forum in which research center's members can present and discuss their work-in-progress, and other research-related seminars and events.

CENTER OF ADVANCED BEHAVIORAL RESEARCH

The Center of Advanced Behavioral Research supports research projects handled by academic faculty across the wide field of psychology, depending on the specific research interests ranging from child psychology to clinical and educational psychology. The main focus in terms of research publications is on faculty serving as course guarantors, to be actively involved in publishing in national and international peer-reviewed journals. These activities are monitored and supported by the departmental Research Lead Tereza Příhodová, M.A., Ph.D. For the publications faculty is being supported by the department and the Research Lead, while both encourage team cooperations and efforts. Team cooperation across different specialties further promotes incorporation UNYP student, providing educative experience and guidance in publication process. All faculty are encouraged to publish with exclusive UNYP affiliation at least once a year. Aside from publications itself, faculty members are encouraged and provided assistance while applying and initiating local and international research projects. Gathered data are further disseminated via conference proceedings and presentations. The Research Lead is available to all psychology faculty member to support their efforts in project initiations and progress. Further, the Research Lead cooperates on publications and manuscript preparations to meet the department's needs and set goals. Faculty is encouraged to reach out for mutual cooperation, guidance, assistance and professional outlook.
