



Tuition & Fees Overview Academic Year 2026 – 2027

Bachelor's Programs

Annual Tuition & Fees – American Bachelor's programs

- **EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 258,500 CZK** ($\approx$ 10,692 EUR / 12,310 USD)
- **International Students: 311,000 CZK** ($\approx$ 12,863 EUR / 14,810 USD)

Tuition Breakdown:

Tuition is calculated based on the number of courses/credits that students are taking per semester. The duration of the American Bachelor's programs is 4 years (2 semesters per year). Students must complete 92 UNYP credits and 32 SUNY - Empire State University credits to graduate. Typically, each course is worth 3 credits. Students pursuing the dual degree option must complete an additional 4 UNYP credits.

Tuition per UNYP credit:

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 8,150 CZK
- International Students: 9,900 CZK

Tuition per SUNY-Empire State University credit:

- 355 USD

Fees Breakdown:

- Application Fee (non-refundable): 2,000 CZK (one time only)
- Student Body Fee: 7,000 CZK per semester
- Reduced Student Body Fee: 3,500 CZK per semester
- Empire State University Admissions Fee: 365 USD (one time only)
- Empire State University Technology Fee: 194 USD per semester
- Transfer Credit Fee: 500 CZK per US credit
- Graduation Fee: 3,500 CZK (one time only)

- For the American Bachelor program, the academic year is divided into two semesters, with each standard semester consisting of 5 courses.
- Students pursuing the dual degree option must complete an additional 4 UNYP credits.
- The reduced student body fee applies to students enrolled in fewer credits per semester and replaces the full student body fee.
- The Empire State University Admissions Fee is charged after the second year of study.
- The Empire State University Technology Fee is charged per semester beginning in the third year of study.
- The transfer credit fee applies only to students transferring courses from previous studies.

Annual Tuition & Fees – European Bachelor's programs

- **EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 258,500 CZK** ($\approx$ 10,692 EUR / 12,310 USD)
- **International Students: 299,000 CZK** ($\approx$ 12,369 EUR / 14,263 USD)

Tuition Breakdown:

Tuition is calculated based on the number of courses/credits that students are taking per semester. The duration of the European Bachelor's programs is 3 years (2 semesters per year). Students must complete 180 ECTS credits to graduate. Typically, each course is worth 6 ECTS credits.

Tuition per UNYP credit:

- EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents: 4,075 CZK
- International Students: 4,750 CZK

Fees Breakdown:

- Application Fee (non-refundable): 2,000 CZK (one time only)
- Student Body Fee: 7,000 CZK per semester
- Reduced Student Body Fee: 3,500 CZK per semester
- Transfer Credit Fee: 250 CZK per ECTS credit
- Graduation Fee: 3,500 CZK (one time only)

American Bachelor's Programs

Example Calculation of Semester Tuition and Fees

EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 3 credits per course = 15 credits

15 credits x 8,150 CZK Tuition per credit = 122,250 CZK + 7,000 Student Body Fee = 129,250 CZK ($\approx$ 5,346 EUR / 6,155 USD)

International Students:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 3 credits per course = 15 credits

15 credits x 9,900 CZK Tuition per credit = 148,500 CZK + 7,000 Student Body Fee = 155,500 CZK ($\approx$ 6,431 EUR / 7,405 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the November 2025 exchange rate.

Freshman students may be required to take one additional credit (Introduction to University Studies) during their first semester.

Example Calculation of Annual Tuition and Fees

EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 3 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 8,150 CZK Tuition per credit = 244,500 CZK + 14,000 Student Body Fee (2 x 7,000 CZK) = 258,500 CZK ($\approx$ 10,692 EUR / 12,310 USD)

International Students:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 3 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 9,900 CZK Tuition per credit = 297,000 CZK + 14,000 Student Body Fee (2 x 7,000 CZK) = 311,000 CZK ($\approx$ 12,863 EUR / 14,810 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the November 2025 exchange rate.

Example Calculation of Semester Tuition and Fees

EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 6 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 4,075 CZK Tuition per credit = 122,250 CZK + 7,000 Student Body Fee = 129,250 CZK ($\approx$ 5,346 EUR / 6,155 USD)

International Students:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 6 credits per course = 30 credits

30 credits x 4,750 CZK Tuition per credit = 142,500 CZK + 7,000 Student Body Fee = 149,500 CZK ($\approx$ 6,183 EUR / 7,130 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the November 2025 exchange rate.

Example Calculation of Annual Tuition and Fees

EU/EFTA Nationals & Czech Permanent Residents:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 6 credits per course = 60 credits

60 credits x 4,075 CZK Tuition per credit = 244,500 CZK + 14,000 Student Body Fee (2 x 7,000 CZK) = 258,500 CZK ($\approx$ 10,692 EUR / 12,310 USD)

International Students:

Standard of 5 courses semester x 2 semesters = 10 courses x 6 credits per course = 60 credits

60 credits x 4,750 CZK Tuition per credit = 285,000 CZK + 14,000 Student Body Fee (2 x 7,000 CZK) = 299,000 CZK ($\approx$ 12,369 EUR / 14,263 USD)

Tuition fees are determined in CZK, with the EUR and USD amounts provided as estimates based on the November 2025 exchange rate.
